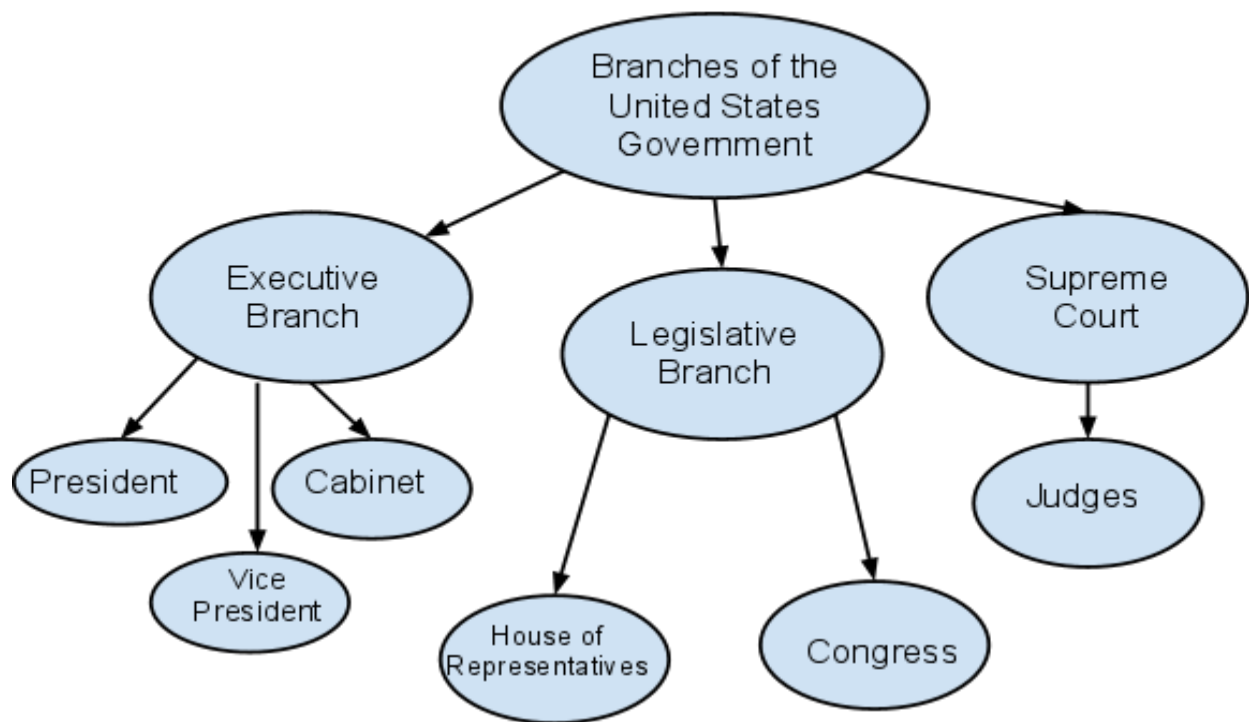


Teaching Writing → Using Graphic Organizers

Graphic organizers can help you organize facts and information before you start writing. A **network tree** is a type of graphic organizer that shows connections. A network tree has many branches to show how facts and information branch off of a main idea or topic.

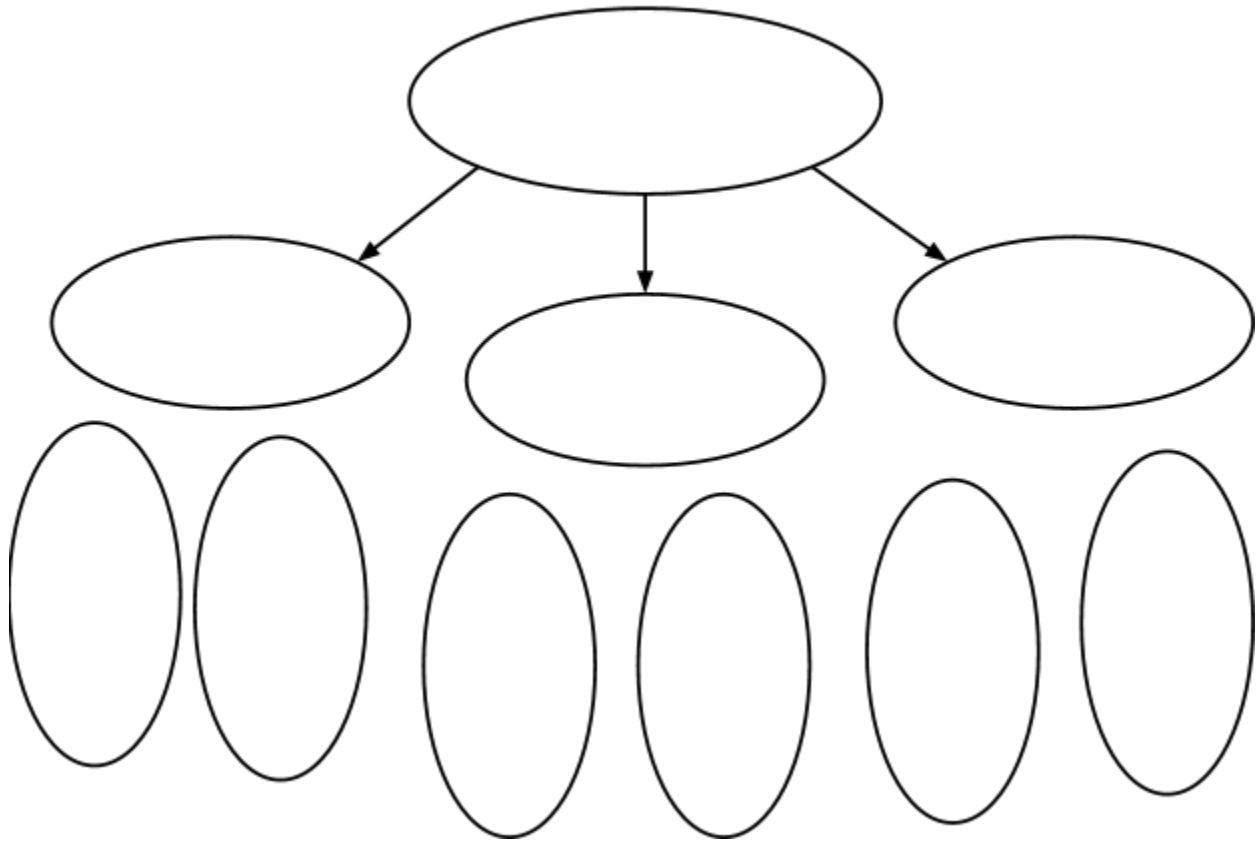
Look at the example network tree below to see how related information is shown. Then, use the blank network tree on the next page to show facts and information that relates to your topic.
